

Modi Rubber completes sale of tyre division to Continental

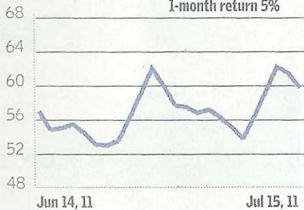
Mumbai, July 15

Modi Rubber has completed the sale of its wholly-owned tyre manufacturing division to Germany's Continental Group on Friday for a total of around Rs 135 crore. In a statement to the bourses, the company said that it's entire 5.6 crore shares in Modi Tyres Company has been sold to Continental. The deal was originally announced in April this
