AIRIA EXPORT AWARD SCHEME

OBJECTIVE

The AIRIA Export Award is primarily to encourage the manufacturer members of the Association, endeavoring to initiate, develop and expand their exports.

1. <u>CATEGORIES OF EXPORT A WARDS:</u>

There will be seven types of Export Awards for excellence in exports viz:

1.1 Best All round Performance : ONE (based on aggregate marks)

1.2 Highest Export Awards : THREE (as mentioned under para 2 of the

scheme)

1.3 Top Export Awards : FIFTEEN (as mentioned under para 3.1 of

the scheme)

1.4 Special Export Awards : FIFTEEN (as mentioned under Para 4.1 of the

Scheme)

1.5 Special Export Award for

Rubber Machinery / Equipment: ONE

1.6 Export Growth Awards : FOUR

1.7 Certificate of Merit : All eligible applicants

HIGHEST / TOP EXPORT AWARD

3.2 **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Manufacturers satisfying the following minimum criteria would be considered for selection for Highest/Top Export Award:-

- 3.2.1 There should be a minimum export turnover of Rs. 50 crores for tyre sector, Rs.30 crores for non tyre large industry, Rs. 10 crores for non-tyre SME/ Medium (MSME) Sector and 75 lakhs for tiny sector during the year under consideration.
- No firm securing less than minimum qualifying marks of 60 on their export achievement/ performance shall be selected for Highest/Top Export Award in category at Sl. No. 3.1.1 to 3.1.15.

3.3 **SELECTION OF FIRMS:**

Selection of firms for Highest/Top Export Award will be made on the basis of Marks allocated on different achievements/activities as per norms indicated below.

3.3.1 EXPORT PERFORMANCE (MAXIMUM MARKS: 60):

One mark will be allocated for each Rs. 5 crore of export for tyre sector, Rs. 2 crore for non tyre large industry, Rs. 80 lakhs for non-tyre MSME sector, and Rs 10 lakhs for Micro sector, subject to a maximum limit of 60 marks.

3.3.2 EXPORT PERFORMANCE AS A PERCENTAGE OF OVERALL SALES (MAXIMUM MARKS: 10):

0.25 marks will be allocated for export of each 1% of overall sales, subject to a maximum of ten marks for the tyre and the large industries. For the SME sector 0.20 marks will be allocated for each 1% of overall sales subject to or maximum of 10 marks.

3.3.3 EXPORT GROWTH/DECLINE (MAXIMUM MARKS: 10):

0.5 mark will be allocated for each 1% increase in export as compared to the actual average export during the preceding 3 years. Negative mark on the same basis will be given in case of decline in export. The maximum limited for positive and negative marks in absolute term is 10.

3.3.4 <u>EXPORT MARKETS (MAXIMUM MARKS: 1</u>0):

3.3.4.1 One mark will be given for every country to which exports have been effected, subject to a maximum of ten marks.

3.3.5 CERTIFICATIONS / APPROVALS (MAXIMUM MARKS: (5)

3.3.5.1 Half mark each will be given for any 10 certifications from the enclosed list.

3.3.6 DEVELOPMENT IN NEW PROCESS (MAXIMUM MARKS: 2.5

Firm of manufacturing unit have developed new process and making Composite material with rubbers will attract one point each maximum of 2.5 marks.

3.3.7 DEVELOPMENT OF IMPORT SUBSTITUE PRODUCT (MAXIMUM MARKS: 2.5)

Firm Developing Import substitute and successfully marketing product in overseas market will be given one point each maximum of 2.5 marks (As per 'Make in India Program)

4.2 <u>ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</u>

Manufacturers satisfying the following minimum criteria would be considered for Special Export Award.

4.2.1 There should be a minimum export turnover of Rs. 25 crores for tyre sector, Rs 15 crores for non tyre large industry, Rs. 5 crore for SME sector and Rs 50 lakhs for Micro sector during the year under consideration.

- 4.2.2 No firm securing less than minimum qualifying marks of 50 on their export achievement/performance shall be selected for Special Export Awards in categories at Sr. Nos. 4.1.1 to 4.1.14 and minimum 50% qualifying marks for SL. No. 4.1.15.
- 4.2.3 For those applicants for Special Export Awards who have come second in the overall evaluation will also be awarded a runner-up award, provided they satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed.

4.3. <u>SELECTION OF FIRMS</u>

Selection of firms for Special Export Awards will be made after detailed examination of the actual performance and on the basis of marks allotted on their different achievements / activities, as per the following norms.

4.3.1 <u>EXPORT PERFORMANCE (MAXIMUM MARKS: 60)</u>:

One mark will be allotted for each Rs. 150 lakhs of export in tyre sector, Rs.60 lakhs for non tyre large industry, Rs.25 lakhs for MSME sector, and Rs 5 lakhs for Micro sector subject to a maximum limit of 60 marks.

4.3.2. <u>EXPORT PERFORMANCE AS A PERCENTAGE OF OVERALL SALE</u> (MIXIMUM MARKS: 10):

0.25 marks will be allotted for export of each 1% of overall sales, subject to a maximum of ten marks.

4.3.3. EXPORT GROWTH / DECLINE (MAXIMUM MARKS: 10)

0.5 mark will be allotted for each 1 % increase in export as compared to the actual average export during the preceding three years. Negative mark on the same basis will be given in case of decline in export. The maximum limit for positive or negative marks in absolute terms is 10.

4.3.4 EXPORT MARKETS (MAXIMUM MARKS: 10)

4.3.4.1 One mark will be given for every country to which exports have been effected, subject to a maximum of ten marks.

4.3.5 CERTIFICATIONS / APPROVALS (MAXIMUM MARKS: (5)

4.3.5.1 Half mark will be given for any 10 certifications from the enclosed list.

4.3.6 DEVELOPMENT IN NEW PROCESS (MAXIMUM MARKS: 2.5)

Firm of manufacturing unit have developed new process and making Composite material with rubbers will attract one point each maximum of 2.5 marks.

4.3.7 <u>DEVELOPMENT OF IMPORT SUBSTITUE PRODUCT (MAXIMUM MARKS: 2.5)</u>

Firm Developing Import substitute and successfully marketing product in overseas market will be given one point each maximum of 2.5 marks (As per 'Make in India Program)

4.4 SPECIAL EXPORT AWARD FOR RUBBER MACHINERY/EQUIPMENTS

There shall be one award in this category. The award for rubber machinery / equipment is for minimum export of Rs. 5 crore for large manufacturers and Rs. 1.5 crore for SME units. The selection of one Special Export Award for rubber machinery / equipment will be as follows with 50% minimum qualifying marks.

4.4.1 EXPORT PERFORMANCE (MAXIMUM MARK 40)

One mark will be allotted for each Rs.20 lakhs for large manufacturers and Rs.5 lakhs for SME sector.

4.4.2 EXPORT PERFORANCE AS A PERCENTAGE OF OVERALL SALE (MAXIMUM MARKS 20)

0.25 mark will be allotted for export each 1% of overall sales, subject to a maximum of twenty marks.

4.4.3 EXPORT GROW TH/DECLINE (MAXIMUM MARKS:10)

0.5 mark will be allotted for each 1% increase in export as compared to the actual average export during the preceding three years. Negative mark on the same basis will be given in case of decline in export. The maximum limit for positive or negative marks in absolute terms is 10.

4.4.4 EXPORT MARKETS (MAXIMUM MARKS: 10)

One mark will be given for every country to which exports have been effected, subject to maximum of ten marks.

4.4.5 DEVELOPMENT OF NEW MACHINERY/EQUIPMENTS (MAXIMUM MARKS 20)

A detailed note on the development of new machinery/equipment need to be submitted by the applicant which will be examined by a three member technical sub-committee to be nominated by the Managing Committee with Chairman of Export Promotion Committee at their Convenience.

5. EXPORT GROWTH AWARDS

5.1 There shall be FOUR awards in this category: One to Large Scale Industry, one to Latex Products, One to General Rubber Products, and one to Micro Sector, based on maximum export growth over the preceding year's exports.

5.2 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 5.2.1 Minimum Export Turnover of Rs. 10 crores for Large Industry, Rs. 3 crores for SSI Sector and Rs 35 lakhs for Micro sector during last 2 years.
- 5.2.2. There should not be more than 10% decline in export during any of the last 3 years provided the exports meet the other requirements.

6. <u>CERTIFICATES OF MERIT</u>

6.1 Certificates of Merit will be given to those exporters who have a minimum of Rs.3 crores in the MSME Sector / Medium and Rs. 8 crores in Large Scale Sector.

6.2 CERTIFICATE OF MERIT FOR RUBBER MACHINER Y/EQUIPMENT

Certificate of Merit will be given for rubber machinery/equipment exporters with minimum export turnover of Rs.1 crore for large industry and Rs.30 lakhs for MSME sector.

Encouragement Award to First-time Exporters

Encouragement Award will be given to manufacturers of rubber goods / machinery / equipment exporters with minimum export turnover of Rs.25 lakhs those who are exporting first time.

7. CERTIFICATES OF MERIT FOR MICRO SECTOR

Certificate of Merit will be given to exporters belonging to micro sector who have a minimum export of Rs 35 lakhs, limited to 2 Certificates only.

8. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR MICRO SECTOR

Manufacturers having total investments in Plant & Machinery up to Rs.25 lacs will be considered as a Micro Unit. Registration Certificate from the concerned Director of Industries/Development Commissioner should be obtained, a Certified True Copy of which is to be submitted. Additionally, a Chartered Accountant's certificate, certifying that the Unit has not crossed the limit of Rs 25 lacs in investments in the current year, also must be submitted in original. The unit must be engaged in export activity for the last 3 years.

9. <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u>

Please follow the INSTRUCTIONS given on Page No. 7 for filing up the Entry Form for AIRIA Export Awards.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING-UP THE ENTRY FORM FOR AIRIA EXPORT AWARDS

- 1) Merchant Exporters are not eligible for the Awards.
- 2) All entries are required to be filled-in types scripts.
- 3) No entry should be kept blank. If any parameter is not applicable or information is not available, please mention clearly 'Not Applicable' or 'Nil' or 'Not Available', as the case may be.
- 4) Answers should be specific for each query.
- 5) Only direct exports will be taken into account for the purpose of selection for Export Award.
- 6) Each entry should be accompanied by necessary audited certificate from Chartered Accountants in support of claims of exports made during the last four years.
- 7) Wherever export value must be mentioned, the figures should be both in terms of Indian Rupees and in U.S. Dollars as far as possible.
- 8) No entry will be considered unless the forms are properly signed with date and office stamp.
- 9) Member firm sending entry for the Award should have paid to the Association all the dues including the current year's annual subscription and should enclose certificate to that effect.
- Any application not confirming to the above mentioned instructions is liable to be rejected.
- 11) The AIRIA can seek additional information from applicant, if required.
- 12) The decision of the Managing Committee shall be final and binding.
