AIRIA Promotes Rubber Industry at International Forums

Domestic rubber industry needs to be made competitive by removal of inverted duty structure, waiving off import duty on synthetic rubbers which are not manufactured in India, withdrawal of safeguard duty on carbon black and antidumping duty on Rubber Chemicals, said Mohinder Gupta.
