

Mohinder Gupta to head rubber industry body

LUDHIANA: During the annual general meeting of the All-India Rubber Industries Association (AIRIA) at New Delhi, Mohinder Gupta, managing director of Vinko Auto Industries Ltd, was re-elected president of the body, recently.
