Apollo Tyres fined ₹30 cr in S Africa
Apollo Tyres has been been asked to cough up
45 million rand (₹30 crore) as penalty for cartelisation, a dispute which the company said related to a period when the firm was managed by Dunlop. The South African Competition Commission said Apollo Tyres (formerly Dunlop) has admitted it took part in a tyre manufacturers' cartel and agreed on pricing and price rises.
