## INDIAN COS SEEK ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON TYRES

In the wake of huge tyre imports, domestic tyre makers are demanding anti-dumping duties on passenger car radials. With China and Thailand pushing imports into India, imported tyres command about 40 per cent of the total replacement market in the country, they complain.

"It is a worrisome trend and we (industry) are working on pushing for anti-dumping duties on passenger car radials (PCR)," said Dr Raghupati Singhania, MD, JK Tyre and Industries Ltd. "The industry has been seeking a safeguard duty for PCRs as there is ample supply in the domestic market. TBR (truck bus radial) tyre imports have come down after the imposition of anti dumping duty," Mr Singhania added.
