

7th India Rubber Expo & Tyre Show 2013 at Bombay Exhibition Centre, Mumbai 22nd-24th Jan 2013


Key Highlights:

The three-day long, 7th International Rubber Exhibition Tyre Show and Conference, India Rubber Expo 2013 was inaugurated at the hands of Dr. Axel Heitmann, Chairman of the board of Lanxess on the eve of 21st Jan. 2013 at hotel Rennaisance, Powai Mumbai. The inaugural event had the entire spectrum of the rubber industry address the gathering. IRE 2013 witnessed around 500 participating companies from India and around the world taking part at the expo, with an estimated turn around of 20,000 visitors from across 42

countries spread over an exhibition area of 30,000 square meters.

A large number of delegations from US, Central America, Europe and Asia visited the IRE and attended the technical conferences. This event has provided great value to the people working in the field of tread rubber manufacturing, retreading and rubber compound mixing.

The panel consists of distinguished technologists and experts in the field of mixing and retreading technology, tyre and equipment manufacturers, compounding specialists, members from standards organization, tread rubber manufacturing and repair material. The expert speakers addressed various aspects of the rubber industry including latest regulations that protect the environment and alternative materials that would ensure achieving this.

The buyer seller meet organized along with CAPEXIL (Chemicals and Allied Products Export Promotion Council) was brought together well over 30 international importers for a one on one interaction with suppliers from India, thus enhancing the export opportunities for adding additional products to the exports list.

IRE 2013 was supported by the Indian Rubber Board, Automotive Tyre Manufacturers Association, IRSG, IRMRA, ACS(Rubber Division), DKG(Germany)m ACMA...... Et. The expo, therefore provided great opportunity for each and every participant, whether from India or abroad

to increase their sales and contacts multi-fold.

With rapid increase on tyre production 28% and tyre export 18% over the years; the Indian riubber industry has been growing in strength and importance, as a part of India's burgeoning role in the global economy. India is the world's largest producer and the third largest consumer of natural rubber and India is



























